

Advisory for Indian students in UK regarding COVID-19

Travelling to India

At present, flights to India are temporarily suspended till 31st March 2020. We are in contact with the High Commission of India who have confirmed that they remain in touch with the Indian authorities concerned and they will keep you all updated about the resumption of flights. Please stay connected with the High Commission of India and us through social media for updates.

Visas due to expire soon

For those Indian nationals whose visas are expiring but who are unable to leave due to the impacts of COVID19, the High Commission of India has confirmed that the Home Office is working on guidance and whilst this is ongoing, they have requested those impacted to not be concerned. They have said that no one will be unfairly penalised for events beyond their control as a result of COVID-19. Meanwhile, everyone should follow the advisories released by the NHS and Public Health England.

If you already have a ticket to travel back to India and are impacted by this restriction, please contact your airline and/or intermediary through which you booked the ticket.

Registration with the High Commission of India

We are aware that universities are shifting to online teaching/assessment and we request you all to stay updated with the guidance released by your respective universities.
